


News and Action Summary for January 13, 2023

The huge—and wonderful—news from the week is that <u>The Berks</u> <u>County Detention Center is EMPTY!</u> The last detainee was released this week, and the facility is scheduled to close at the end of January. The Shut Down Berks Coalition celebrates this outcome, and urges the county to turn the facility into a center for healing and health care for county residents—which was closer to the original intent.



We also have an update on the story concerning the reparations

negotiations for Bethel AME Church in Pittsburgh. We are pleased to announce <u>'A Historical Moment':</u> <u>Bethel AME Church Near Deal with Penguins to Return to Old Arena Site</u>. We'll be watching for when a final deal is reached.

Unfortunately, the political landscape remains nearly as chaotic—perhaps more so—than what existed in the session that ended with 2022. We pray that cooler and more thoughtful heads will begin to prevail. In the meantime, it probably wouldn't hurt to let your legislators know that you would like for them to work toward the benefit of their constituents, and not play for media attention, power, and political gain.
